2012 MSRA Rule Proposals for February General Membership Meeting:

- 1) PAYOFF SECTION Page 51 Rule 7: ~~DELETED Ground Money.~~ Ground money (entry fee less stock charge and MSRA sanction and finals fee) will be paid to the stock contractor. Added money will be returned to the sponsor of added money.
- 2) PAYOFF SECTION Page 51 Rule 8: ~~DELETED Day Money.~~ If day money is to be paid, each performance will be paid off following rodeo procedures, as if it were a separate rodeo. If there are no qualified rides, entry fees will be refunded to the contestant.
- 3) PAYOFF SECTION Page 51 ADD RULE **MSFR FINALS PAYOFF.** For the Mid States Finals Rodeo, special payoff to be a determined by the MSRA Board of Directors, pending total added money and entry fees.
- 4) RODEO ACTIVITY SECTION Page 47 Rule 9 b: Change Rule: **Timing.** Two hand held digital watches must be used in the timed events and rough stock events. In timed events, all digits beyond ~~hundredths~~ **tenths** will be ignored (except in the Barrel Racing, see Barrel Racing rules for timers). Official time shall be the average of the two times, ignoring any digits beyond the ~~hundredths~~ **tenths**. If one of the two timers misses the start or stop or is delayed in starting or stopping the watch, or if the watch used by one timer malfunctions, that timer shall declare the problem to the other timer and only the time recorded by the other timer will be used.
- 5) FINALS RODEO SECTION ADD RULE: **Timed Event Attempts.** At the MSFR, the allowed number of attempts in each event (i.e. Number of loops or jump attempts in the timed events) is to be determined by the Event Director. The number of attempts is to be notified to contestants at time of entry for the MSFR.
- 6) FINALS RODEO SECTION Page 26 Rule 4 b: Change Rule: **Qualification to Provide Riding Event Livestock.** To qualify to provide riding-event livestock to the Finals Rodeo, a Stock Contractor must serve as the Primary Stock Contractor for a minimum of ~~two (2)~~ **three (3)** MSRA first approved rodeos ~~or five (5) co-approved MSRA rodeos~~ during the corresponding rodeo year.
- 7) COWGIRLS BARREL RACING SECTION Page 81 Rule 9 e: Change Rule: **Working Barrel Pattern.** Once the barrel pattern has been staked, no contestant shall work a **competing** horse on barrels or stakes at anytime prior to the **contestant and/or competing horses** competition run. Failure to comply will result in disqualification and/or a \$50 fine
