

Rule Proposals for 2023

Proposal #1

Page 54 Payoff

3. Number of placings and percentages of prize money

Add the following to this section:

- e. When only (5) contestants qualify for a six money payoff, money shall be divided 33-25-19-13-10.

Proposal #2

Page 11.

- o. Associate Membership. Remove rule due to outdated.

Propasal #3

Page 11 add iii

A one-time day permit for the following specific contract personnel: pickup men, bullfighter, barrel man contract act, and announcer. Contract worker can only use permit one time in a rodeo season. If personnel works another MSRA first approved rodeo in the same year, worker must purchase a MSRA membership in full. Specific contract personnel permit will be \$80.00.

Proposal #4

Page 32. Paragraph #4

Rule reads as follows: The stock contractor and rodeo secretary must be card holders of the MSRA. Stock contractors are responsible for their secretary.

Change rule to read: The stock contractor and rodeo secretary must be card holders of the MSRA. Stock contractors are responsible for their secretary. Rodeo secretary must pass a written test and/or secretary clinic approved by the MSRA and have board approval before working a MSRA first approved rodeo.

Proposal #4

Page 16 paragraph b.

Rule reads as follows: Anyone not repaying an overpayment after being notified by the MSRA office that an error was made by a rodeo secretary will be fined at the discretion of the board of directors.

Change rule to read: Due to overpayment of prize money the contestant must be notified by the rodeo secretary and prize money collected by said secretary. The rodeo secretary shall send in all monies to the MSRA office with no deductions of payments owed due to overpayment of prize money. Any contestant

that does not repay an overpayment after being notified by the rodeo secretary will be assessed a fine at the discretion of the board of directors and placed on a suspended list.

Proposal #5

Page 33 paragraph 7.

Rule reads as follows: Events: All MSRA rodeos must have seven standard events, bareback bronc riding, tie-down roping, saddle bronc riding, steer wrestling, bull riding, cowgirls barrel racing, team roping. Cowgirls breakaway roping is an optional event.

Change rule to read: All MSRA rodeos must have eight standard events, bareback bronc riding, tie-down roping, saddle bronc riding, steer wrestling, bull riding, cowgirls barrel racing, team roping and cowgirl's breakaway roping.

If rule passes, all rules pertaining to CGBKR will be changed to adding CGBKR as a standard event throughout the rule book.

Proposal #6

Page 54 3. d.

11 or more contestants & there is \$1,501.00 or more in any one event.

Clarify rule to read: 11 or more contestants & there is \$ 1,501.00 or more in any event. The header and heeler in the team roping are separate events.

Proposal #7

Page 74 3. General Rules, Add paragraph zz. A designated time before each performance for the timed event contestants to ride in the Arena. Time in the arena must be given before the rodeo, during intermission and before slack. Time allowance should be at least 10 minutes.

Proposal #8

Page 82 3. Add paragraph m. When two sections of cowgirls' barrel racing are in the performance, contractor must drag before each section and/or after 12 including turn outs.
